About Camp Pine Mountain: Situated on 35 acres and established in 1923, Camp Pine Mountain has a rich heritage of supporting scouting. With campsites around a large activity field, facilities include a covered pavilion, multiple picnic tables, a chapel, campfire area, potable water, shower house, flushing latrines, fishing, archery and BB rifle ranges.

General Information: Pack 29 will be occupying two campsites - Riverside & Carter. These campsites are halfway up the hill from the bathhouse, near the chimney. Camp staff will be available to check us in on Friday evening and Saturday morning. If you arrive on Saturday, check-in will be between 7:30-9:00 am (EDT). You will not be able to drive to the campsite. There will be volunteers available with a trailer to take your gear to camp. Saturday morning will be very busy, so be prepared for a little chaos. If you do arrive on Saturday, realize that you can always bring your gear to camp later in the day. There will not be electricity available at the campsite.

All activities will occur on Saturday, beginning at 9:20 am (EDT). During the day, we will rotate through Archery, BB Gun Shooting, Field Games, and Craft activities. In the evening, the Haunted House, Hay Ride, Carnival, and Movie will take place. Of course, we'll have the AU-Ole Miss football game on the radio at camp as well.

All of the meals will be provided by the Pack. There will be plenty of snacks provided by the pack as well, but it wouldn't be a bad idea to bring a few that you like as well. The Akela Grill on-site sells snacks, burgers and t-shirts.

We could always use some firewood.

Activity Details:

Archery - Scouts will be assisted by certified instructors in shooting bows and arrows at targets. The bows and arrows are just the right size for a cub scout. Be sure to follow the range safety rules!

Shooting Sports - Scouts will be assisted by certified instructors in shooting either BB guns or slingshots at targets. Be sure to follow the range safety rules!

Field Games - The Field Games will include an obstacle course and other activities.

Crafts - Some type of handicraft will be offered and this is a good change of pace from all of the other more active activities. Your creative juices can flow! There is an additional \$5 fee for siblings that participate in crafts.

Haunted House - An age appropriate haunted house is available for those who wish to chance it!

Hay Ride - Enjoy an old fashioned hay ride through camp!

Carnival - There will be a typical carnival in the activity building with games, prizes, etc.

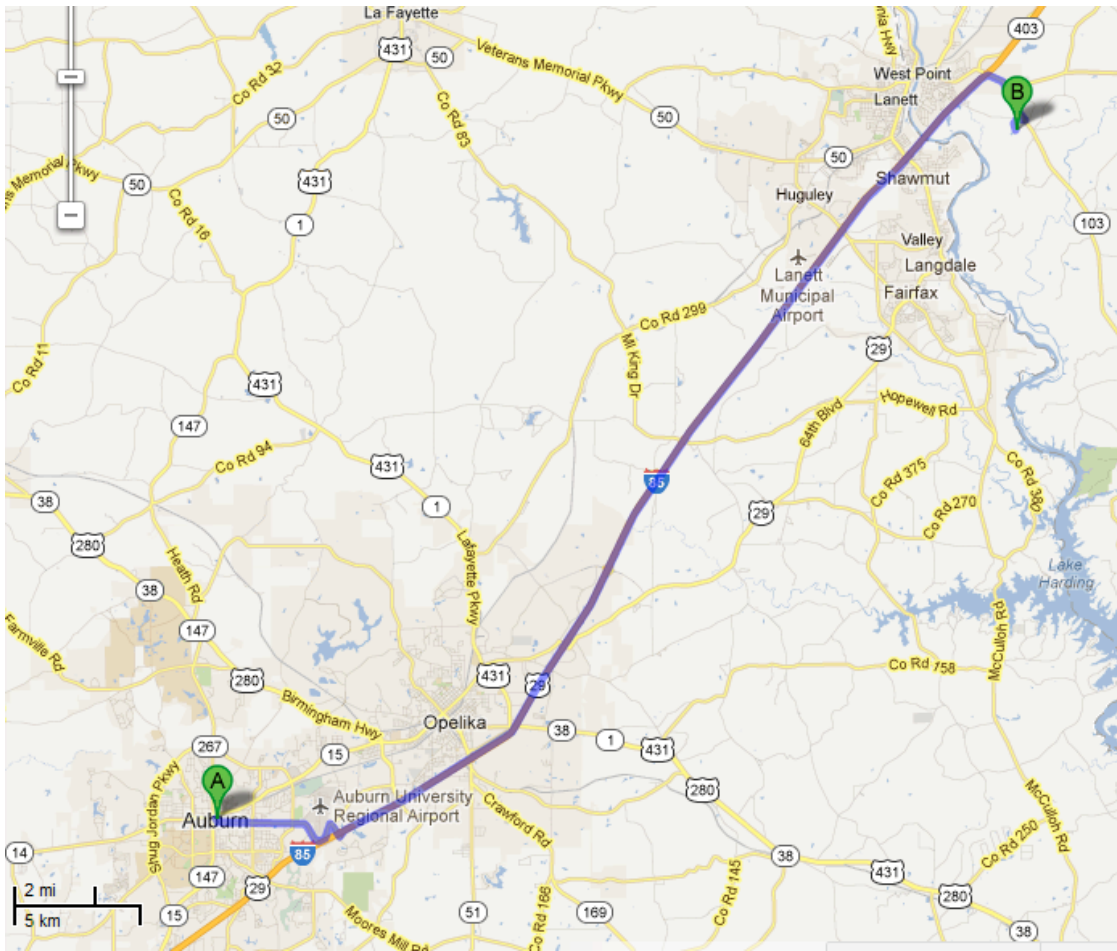
Fishing - Throughout the campout you may try your luck in the lakes. Bring your own fishing tackle and bait. Adult supervision is required for this activity!

Directions to Camp: On the way up:

Take Interstate 85 North towards Atlanta. Take Exit 2 (GA Hwy 18, West Point/Pine Mountain). At the stop sign turn right and travel east on GA Hwy 18 approximately one half mile. Turn right on GA Hwy 103 (first road to the right). Go approximately one mile and turn right onto old West Point Road (this is the second paved road to your right). As you start down the hill, turn into the first driveway on your left. This is the entrance to Camp Pine Mountain.
